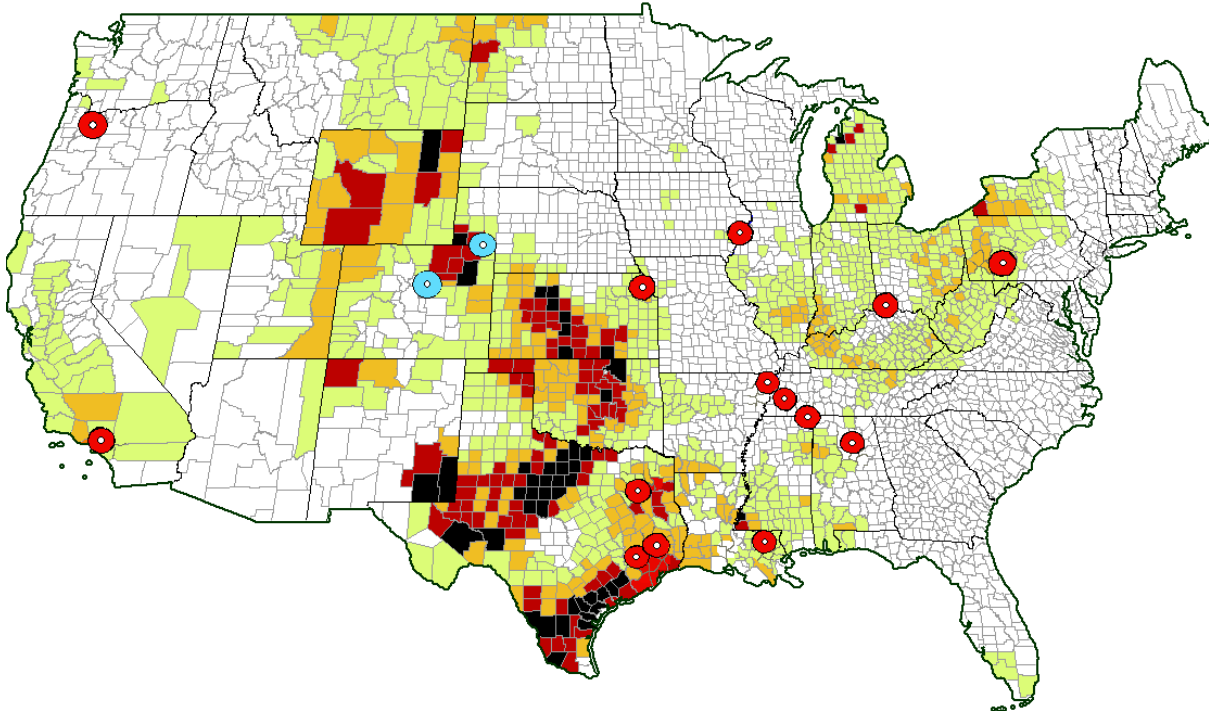


WHY COAT YOUR PIPE AS CLOSE TO THE JOBSITE AS POSSIBLE?

1. Coating at a job-site coater increases your pipe supply options.
2. Rail cars are professionally and carefully unloaded at no charge.
3. Pipe is inventoried, inspected, and stored free of charge for 6 months on a secure, stabilized yard.
4. Coating your pipe locally allows you or your representative easy access to the pipe for inspection.
5. A job-site coating facility provides an independent inspection of your pipe, documenting pipe mill compliance with your purchase order.
6. Extensive coating damage from rail shipping is eliminated, reducing contractor backcharges.
7. Stringing trucks can arrive at your job-site from a reliable, properly equipped pipe yard.
8. Coating at a local coating facility supports the local economy and ensures long-term availability of pipe coating services for emergency or short-order needs.
